- Board of Education – Anne Fischer – only 3200 students in school system due to demographics.
 Discussion on this at BOE meeting 10/17 7:00 PM.
 - Mary Stone – when is next year’s calendar out? AF – January/February.
 - Talk of regionalized school calendars perhaps next year starting after Labor Day. AF – will be set by CREC.
- Principal's Report – Jocelyn Poglitsch & Mike DeBellis
 - MD – T.Y. for attendance to ice cream social, great success.
 - School Governance Council meeting – finalized new parent student compact(?) going home to all families next month. Guidelines for all. Standalone doc in addition to handbook. Aligned w/ CRS core values RRR.
 - Building leadership team working on school improvement plan. District comes out with improvement plan, 3 goals. Each school takes goals and makes own. Focus at CRS objective #1 collaboration/community: provide more resources & opportunities for parents to use at home to reinforce school at home. Ex: end of unit ‘celebration’, invite parents to that. At PTO meetings have presentations by teachers.
 - Note next week from Mr. Burt (Assistant Superintendent) – new screening test for math & reading. Computer based test designed to change questions based on responses given. Should give more detailed report to teachers. Only 2x this year, years forward will be 3x. Six hour training on election day PD. Unclear if it’s replacing existing testing.
 - Dan Nevelos – question on # of kids in 3rd grade. MD – it’s on the borderline on size. Adding additional help, intervention time blocks.
