OFFICERS REPORTS

- Board of Education – Laurie Bajorek – Anne Fischer relayed feedback on feasibility study to BOE after our last PTO meeting. Regina Lee did presentation on Gifted & Talented, VPS district is under identifying currently, 108 ID'd currently. Would like a 2nd G&T teacher in district. Legally we are supposed to ID K-12, currently VPS is only reviewing grades 4 – 12 using CMT (past), MAP, SBAC. Also recommendations from teachers.
