

WHAT PTO DOES WITH THE MONEY WE RAISE...

The PTO has such an important job when it comes to funding and planning out the school year! We try to plan a lot of fun events as well as support our teachers and staff at Center Road School. And yes, we do this through fundraising...and some would say a lot of fundraising! But it all goes towards making your children's elementary school years as fun as possible!! So, ever wonder just what we do with the money we raise? Well here is a brief description of all the wonderful things the PTO does:

Administration: As with any organization, there are fees that need to be paid

- Insurance
- Non Profit Status
- Supplies
- Taxes
- Technology

Appreciation: Money is used to show how much we appreciate the teachers and staff at CRS

- Bagels and Cream Cheese Breakfast on the 1st Day of School
- Items other than food for the 2 Potluck lunches during American Education Week and Teacher Appreciation Week

Assemblies: Money is used to fund school wide and individual grade assemblies such as visiting authors, Pin Hole Camera, end of year celebration, etc.

Family Dance: Money is used to pay the DJ. As well as any decorations and non-food items needed.

Field Trips: The PTO pays for the transportation, per grade, per field trip or if that grade wishes to forgo a bus and have a field trip in house, we will pay for that instead.

5th Grade Boston Trip: The PTO funds the entire 5th Grade trip for students and their teachers.

5th Grade Yearbook: Each 5th grade student receives a free yearbook at the end of the year!

Ice Cream Social: Money is used to purchase ice cream, toppings, and paper goods. And we also pay for a Kitchen Staff Member who is required to be there.

Donations: We provide donations to the Rockville High Marching Band, Project Graduation, and The Strong Farm Chicken Run

Summer Reading Program: Every student in Kindergarten through 4th grade receives a free book at the end of the year to kick off their summer reading!!

Scholarships: Center Road School PTO gives scholarships to 3 graduating Rockville High students who were previous students at CRS.

Teacher/Classroom: Each teacher and staff member is given an allotted amount of money where they can buy supplies for their classroom.
